### Market Comment

6.68 Mnkg of tea were on offer at this weeks Colombo Tea Auction 2.81 Mnkg were Low Grown Main Grades and 2.36 Mnkg were High and Mid Grown Main Grades.

Low Growns met with fair demand. BOP1s sold at firm to dearer rates. Select best liquoring OP1s were firm, whilst others sold at lower rates. Select best and best OP/ OPA sold at lower rates; whilst poorer varieties were firm to dearer. Pekoe's gained in value all-round. Pekoe1's were barely steady.

In the Tippy Small leaf catalogues select best FBOP1s gained in value; whilst others were firm on last. FBOPs and FBOPF1s were mostly sold at lower rates. Well-made stylish FBOPFs held firm; best varieties lost out in value; others held firm. BOP / BOPFs were barely steady on last week's levels. In the Premium Flowery catalogues long leaf tippy teas sold at lower rates, whilst FBOPFSP varieties held firm.

Ex-Estate catalogues met with fair general demand. Better and below best Western BOP / BOPFs were lower upto Rs. 20, whilst the bottom was about firm. No Nuwara Eliya BOPs were on offer this week, whilst BOPFs were firm to slightly dearer. Better Udapussellawa BOP / BOPFs were irregularly lower upto Rs. 20. Clean Uva BOP / BOPFs were dearer Rs. 10 to Rs. 20, whilst thebottom maintained. Medium BOP / BOPFs were lower Rs. 10 to Rs. 20. CTC BP1s were dearer upto Rs. 20, whilst CTC PF1s were irregularly lower RS. 10 to Rs. 20.

#### Sri Lanka 1H Tea Production down 29.8 Mnkg YoY 2019

An analysis of Sri Lanka Tea Production data released by the Sri Lanka Tea Board reveals that 129 Mnkg was produced during January – June this year, compared with 158.8 Mnkg the year before. This is a loss of 19% totaling 29.8 Mnkg and the lowest in twenty four years. During the period 2013 to 2015 production ranged from 172 to 174 Mnkg and in the subsequent four years the six month figure ranged from 154 to 158 Mnkg.

Around 60% of National Production comes from the Low Country and it is of great concern that 77% of the loss of production totaling 23 Mnkg is from the this sector. This year's 1H Low Grown production figure of 75.4 Mnkg is the lowest since 1999. The severe drought during January – March caused significant loss of plants. Ruhuna Agro Climatic district of the Low country, worst hit was Galle, Matara and Kalutara followed by Deniyaya and Ratnapura in Sabaragamuwa.

High Growns declined from 34.5 Mnkg during 1H 2019 to 30.8 Mnkg this year; a loss of 10%. The figure 30.8 Mnkg is the lowest since the El-Nino year of 1992. In the past four years High Growns produced 34 Mnkg to 36 Mnkg in the first half. Three years before that recorded production ranged around 41 Mnkg to 43 Mnkg

Sri Lanka produced 26.8 Mnkg in the month of June compared with 27.5 Mnkg last year. High Growns recorded YoY increase of 14% with production of 7.2 Mnkg against 6.3 Mnkg in 2019. Mediums eased marginally to 4.2 Mnkg from 4.5 Mnkg a year ago. Low Growns dropped from 16.6 Mnkg to 15.3 Mnkg this year.

#### Sri Lanka Tea Bags exports recover in June

Customs data confirms that Sri Lanka exported 2.19 Mnkg of Tea Bags in the month of June. Exports of tea in this value added form declined to 0.94 Mnkg during the shutdown period in April and picked up to 1.55 Mnkg in May. The June quantity of 2.19 Mnkg is also higher than the previous year's monthly figure of 1.89 Mnkg.

The Country exported a total of 23.6 Mnkg in June; this is marginally lower than the previous year's figure of 24.1 Mnkg, but ahead of May quantity of 22.6 Mnkg.

Total exports for 1H 2020 reached 124 Mnkg but trails the previous year's quantity of 145 Mnkg. This years exports were impacted negatively by poor Q1 tea production with the cumulative YoY shortfall to June reaching 29.8 Mnkg. The country has earned Rs. 106 bln down 13% on previous year's value of Rs. 121 bln. This converts to an approximate USD 571 Mn compared with USD 686 Mn in 2019 and 1H figure of USD 728 Mn in 2018.

Iraq is the main destination with absorption of 16.2 Mnkg down from 19.6 Mnkg a year ago. Turkey follows at 15.7 Mnkg against 18.1 Mnkg last year. Exports to Russia picked up in June to reach 14.4 Mnkg; marginally lower than 14.9 Mnkg the year before. Iran quantities declined 14% from 10.3 to 8.9 Mnkg; followed by Azerbaijan down to 5.3 Mnkg this year. China imported 5 Mnkg by 1H 2020 down 16% from 6 Mnkg during the same period the year before. Chile rose sharply to 4.6 Mnkg from 2.5 Mnkg a year ago and is followed by Syria 3.5 Mnkg. Saudi Arabia a high value market has increased imports of Ceylon Tea to 3.4 Mnkg from 3.1 Mnkg in 2019. UAE 3.3 Mnkg, Libya 3.2 Mnkg and Germany 3 Mnkg are the other major importing markets.
